



Gastrointestinal Illness Letter

Dear Parents/Gaurdians,

We are always updating our procedures and policies to improve the quality of care and safety to all campers.

As part of these ongoing updates we strongly recommend that any child who has any symptoms of gastrointestinal illness, such as vomiting or diarrhoea within 48 hours of attending camp, not attend. The reason for this is the extremely contagious nature and severity of viral gastroenteritis and the high risk of other campers becoming infected while in close contact, such as a camping environment.

The health & welfare of all campers is our highest priority. If any camper arrives on camp with any symptoms of gastrointestinal illness, it is our policy that they will be quarantined and arrangements will be made via parents or guardians to transport the patient home (at their expense).
