



Not to Bring List

The following list of items are **NOT** to be brought to any **Holiday Camps Victoria** camp.

- Electronic devices; including mobile phones, ipods, walkmans, stereos, or electronic games.
- Valuable watches and jewellery.
- Junk Food; all food is supplied including snack food throughout the day.
- Alcohol, cigarettes and illicit drugs
- No large amounts of money. Small change can be brought for public phone but 1800 Reverse would be advisable.

Please Note:

- All medication must include your name and the dosage clearly labelled and given on arrival to first aid leader.
- Our camps are peanut and nut free camps. Please do not bring anything that has any traces of peanuts or nuts. This is due to the serious nature of nut allergies which can result in severe allergic reactions or even fatalities.
- Long pants, shoes and socks must be worn outside, all year round, while participating in adventure activities. Please be aware clothing may get wet, dirty or damaged when involved in adventure programs.
- If a camera is brought to camp it is solely the responsibility of the camper. Holiday Camps Victoria Pty Ltd will not accept any liability for loss or damage.
- It is recommended that brand new or expensive clothes should not be brought to camp and that old, casual and easily washable clothes be brought instead.
- All clothes and other personal items should be clearly name tagged to avoid loss.
